Under 13s Denied win by late Parnells goal

Erin go Bragh 6-7 (25) Parnells 5-12 (27)

An entertaining game of football in Hazelbury Park on Saturday saw the Under 13s denied their third win of the season with Parnells scoring a late goal to take the points.

Erin go Bragh started the game brightly dominating the first ten minutes and opening the scoring. But Parnells responded strongly scoring 2-8 without rely. The home team finished the second half well, matching their opponents scoring 1-1 to Parnells 0-2 and the scoreline at half time reading 1-2 to 2-10 in favour of Parnells.

Parnells started the second half strongly scoring an early goal and a point, but with the wind behind them Erin go Bragh fought back taking over the second half and pulling back a 15 point deficit to take a two point lead going into the final ten minutes. Emanuel N'Kencho hit the cross bar with a powerful shot but it was Parnells who would have the final say scoring a goal (which some spectators and players thought was into the side netting and not the goal) and a point to steal the game and hold off a spirited Erin go Bragh fight back.

Sadly despite Erin go Bragh winning the second half 5-5 to 2-2 it was Parnells who walked away with the points on the day.

Lotto 2010 Update
